How to Set-Up the Roku at home

- 1) Plug in the Roku using the black power-cord.
- 2) Connect the Roku to your TV using one of the following:
 - a. If you have a STANDARD, NON-HD TV: use the red/yellow/white composite cable
 - b. If you have an HDTV: use the black HDMI cord
- 3) Select the appropriate source on your TV, based on into which port you plugged the cable (ex: HDMI1, AV2, etc.)
- 4) Wait for the Roku to turn on and get to the home-screen.
- 5) To connect your Roku to your home wireless network:
 - a. Settings \rightarrow Network \rightarrow Wireless (Wi-Fi) \rightarrow Set-up New Wi-Fi Connection
 - b. Select your home wireless network
 - c. Enter your password (if applicable)
 - d. The Roku will run through its wi-fi set-up process and should connect automatically.
- 6) Select the Home button on the remote (it looks like a house) to return to the home-screen.

How to Access Library Movies Using VUDU

- 1) Select "VUDU Movies & TV" on the Roku home-screen.
- 2) To access titles owned by Saxton B. Little, scroll to "**MY VUDU**" on the top of the screen using the arrow keys. Titles on other screens (including "Discover," etc.) are not available for play.
- 3) Using the arrow keys, choose **MOVIES** or **TV SHOWS**.
- 4) Select an item using the OK button on the remote.
- 5) Enjoy!

Keep in mind:

- The Roku does **NOT** have an on/off switch the only way to shut it off is to remove it from the power source. Simply unplug the Roku from its power-cord to shut it off.
- Make sure the front of the Roku box is not blocked otherwise it won't be able to communicate with the remote.
- Not all content is available on all channels without logging in to a cable provider or paying an additional subscription fee. <u>DO NOT ENTER IN YOUR OWN INFORMATION</u> (per the Roku Lending Policy you signed before checking out the Roku)
