

Tutoring Policy
Saxton B. Little Free Library

Approved by the Library Board June 24, 2004
Reviewed January 23, 2012; Revised August 22, 2016

Tutors may tutor students at the tables in the Library or may use the Programming Room when available.

Tutoring sessions held at the tables in the public areas of the Library may not disturb or impede the use of the Library by other patrons.

All Library sponsored events and programs supersede tutoring sessions.

Students under the age of 12 are the responsibility of the tutor and must be supervised at all times.

The Library administration reserves the right to restrict tutoring activities during high use periods.

Failure on the part of the tutor or the student to exhibit courteous and respectful behavior shall result in the denial of tutoring privileges at the Library.
